We actively encourage our children to wear school uniform and ask for your help and support with our school uniform policy. We believe that a uniform looks smart, is practical, and contributes to a sense of belonging and to the health and safety of your child in the school environment.

Much of our uniform can be bought in high street shops but school specific items can be bought from Trutex. Some items (detailed below) are sold by school and these can be purchased from reception.

Uniform

- Bottle green sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan, preferably with school logo
- Bottle green fleece jacket with school logo (optional) [from Trutex]
- Yellow polo shirt, preferably with school logo
- Tailored grey/black school trousers, shorts, pinafore dress or skirt
- Grey or bottle green tights
- Grey, black, green or white socks
- Black, brown or navy closed in school shoes (no open toes, high heels or trainers please)
- Green and white striped or checked dress or separates for the summer

Other essential garments (seasonal)

- Warm, waterproof coat with hood for colder weather, and a waterproof coat for warmer days. Children must have a coat in school every day in case the weather changes.
- Boots (including Wellington boots) should not be worn unless required due to weather conditions. If boots are worn for that reason, school shoes should be brought to school so that the child may change out of his/her boots for the classroom.
- Sunhat in hot weather
- Sandals (black, brown or navy, no heels and must have a closed toe), can be worn in the summer term
- Wellington Boots (for Forest School)
- Waterproof trousers (for Forest School)
- Long sleeved top to wear in summer months (Forest School)

Physical Education

- Navy blue or black shorts
- Plain white T-shirt
- Trainers with Velcro fastening (inexpensive trainers not designer)
- Black or navy blue jogging bottoms and a jumper or plain hoodie (seasonal)
- A hair tie, if necessary - long hair must be tied back for all P.E. activities
- Spare pair of socks if your child wears tights to school
- A labelled drawstring bag to keep the kit in in school (no rucksacks please)

Other items available from school

- Drawstring P.E. bag with school logo
- Green book bag with school logo

Jewellery

We prefer children not to wear jewellery but will allow:

- Plain stud earrings, which must be removed by your child or covered by your child with sticky tape for P.E. If a child is wearing earrings and cannot remove them her/himself or cover them her/himself for P.E, then she/he will not take part in the session but will observe from the side. A note will be sent home advising the child's parents that she/he did not take part.
- Analogue watches (no novelty watches, digital or fit bits please)

If you are considering having your child's ears pierced, we would recommend that it is done at the start of the summer holidays, allowing time for the healing process and giving your child the opportunity to become familiar with removing and replacing the earrings. Please be aware that, on the grounds of health and safety, staff are not permitted to remove or replace children's earrings.

As with plain stud earrings, any watch must be able to be removed for P.E. by your child and is his/her responsibility.

If wearing jewellery is part of your religion or culture, please discuss this with the headteacher.

Accessories

Children may wear plain, appropriately sized, hair accessories for school. They may wear plain, unadorned outdoor seasonal accessories including hats and gloves e.g simple beanie hats. Nail varnish and tattoos cannot be worn.

Hairstyles

Whilst it is a rare occurrence, the headteacher reserves the right, if he/she deems it necessary, to inform the parent/carer if, in his/her opinion, a child's haircut is inappropriate for school.

It is essential that all items of uniform are clearly named and checked regularly as names wear off and adhesive labels can fall out. When relevant, please ensure the names of previous owners are clearly erased – thank you.
