Safety Information: Car Parking



In order to maximise the safety of our children, please follow the guidelines below for parent/visitor parking.

- ❖ **'Kiss and Drop'** operates in the first bus bay for Velmead children each morning.
'Kiss and Drop' means driving to the kerb to allow your child to exit the car onto the footpath. If an adult needs to exit the car, please do not use 'Kiss and Drop', as this is intended to be a quick flowing process.
- ❖ **No parking at all in the bus bays** between 8.30-9.00am and 2.50-3.40pm.
- ❖ **No parking, waiting or stopping is permitted in the red hatched zone.** Children must not get in and out of cars in this area.
- ❖ Children **must not** cross the red hatched area on their way to or from vehicles: the footpath and crossings must be used.
- ❖ Parking in the areas allocated for disabled parking is restricted to disabled badge holders or those granted permission and issued with a permit from either headteacher.
- ❖ Driving or parking past the Velmead school sign i.e. beyond the blue gates is for **PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY**.
- ❖ Parents dropping off or collecting children from the SCL before and after school care should park in the **parent/visitor car park** and walk around the right hand side of the school.

Thank you for your cooperation with these arrangements: not adhering to the guidelines will put our children at serious risk of harm and may result in individuals being barred from the site or closure of the Parent/Visitor car park.

An outline map of the parking arrangements is included – please note that there is a one way system in place, as indicated by the arrows on the map.
