Continuous provision

- Blending EYFS with Year 1

- Support children to read and spell Year R and Year 1 common exception words

- Twice half-termly maths challenge
- Once half-termly home learning
- Mental Maths Toolkit – little and often
(copy home each term to show progress / areas of need)

P.E

- P.E Bags in school every day
- P.E kit - named (shorts and trousers/leggings for the cold weather, t-shirt and sweatshirt/hoodie, plimsolls/trainers, socks)
- Navy and white is ideal
- Earrings taped or removed
- Hair tied back if long (boy/girl)
- Monday and Thursday (subject to change)
- Outside companies (Hockey, Tennis, Skipping)
