CLOTHING ARRANGEMENTS YEAR R & HERON CLASS

- Children come **into** school wearing their Outdoor Learning clothes (see list) for the day. No school uniform is needed.
- Children wear their school shoes to school.
- Children bring their Outdoor Learning waterproofs and wellies in a named carrier bag (NOT their P.E bag). If your child has a puddle suit please ensure your child knows how to put it on and fasten it.

CLOTHING ARRANGEMENTS YEAR 1 & 2

- Children come **into** school wearing their Outdoor Learning clothes (long sleeves, long trousers).
- Children wear their school shoes to school.
- Children bring their Outdoor Learning waterproofs, wellies **AND school uniform** in a named bag to change into after Outdoor Learning.

CLOTHING

- Sweatshirt / Long sleeved top
- Wellies - in a named bag
- Water Bottle
- Warm Socks / Extra socks incase they get wet
- Long Trousers - due to the risk of ticks
- Waterproof coat

COLD & WET DAYS

- Waterproof warm coat
- Base layers or thermals
- Layers - another long sleeved top
- Another pair of warm socks
- Hat, scarf and gloves
