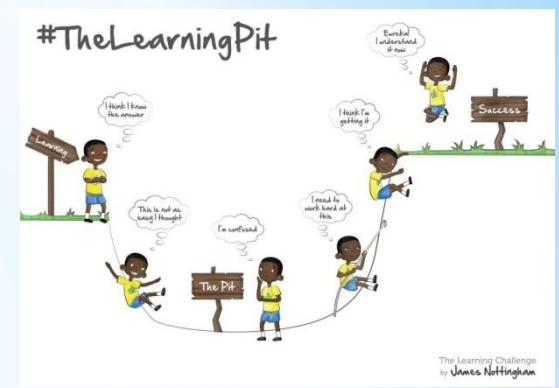


# Resilience

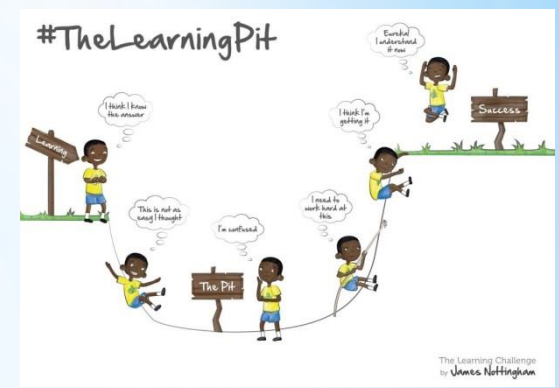


The Learning Pit is a tool to support learners with challenges.

It enables them to visualise the process of managing challenge and how to overcome fears. What is stopping me?

When a learner is posed with a question or enquiry that they perceive as 'hard' we can support them to tackle this in a positive way.

# Resilience

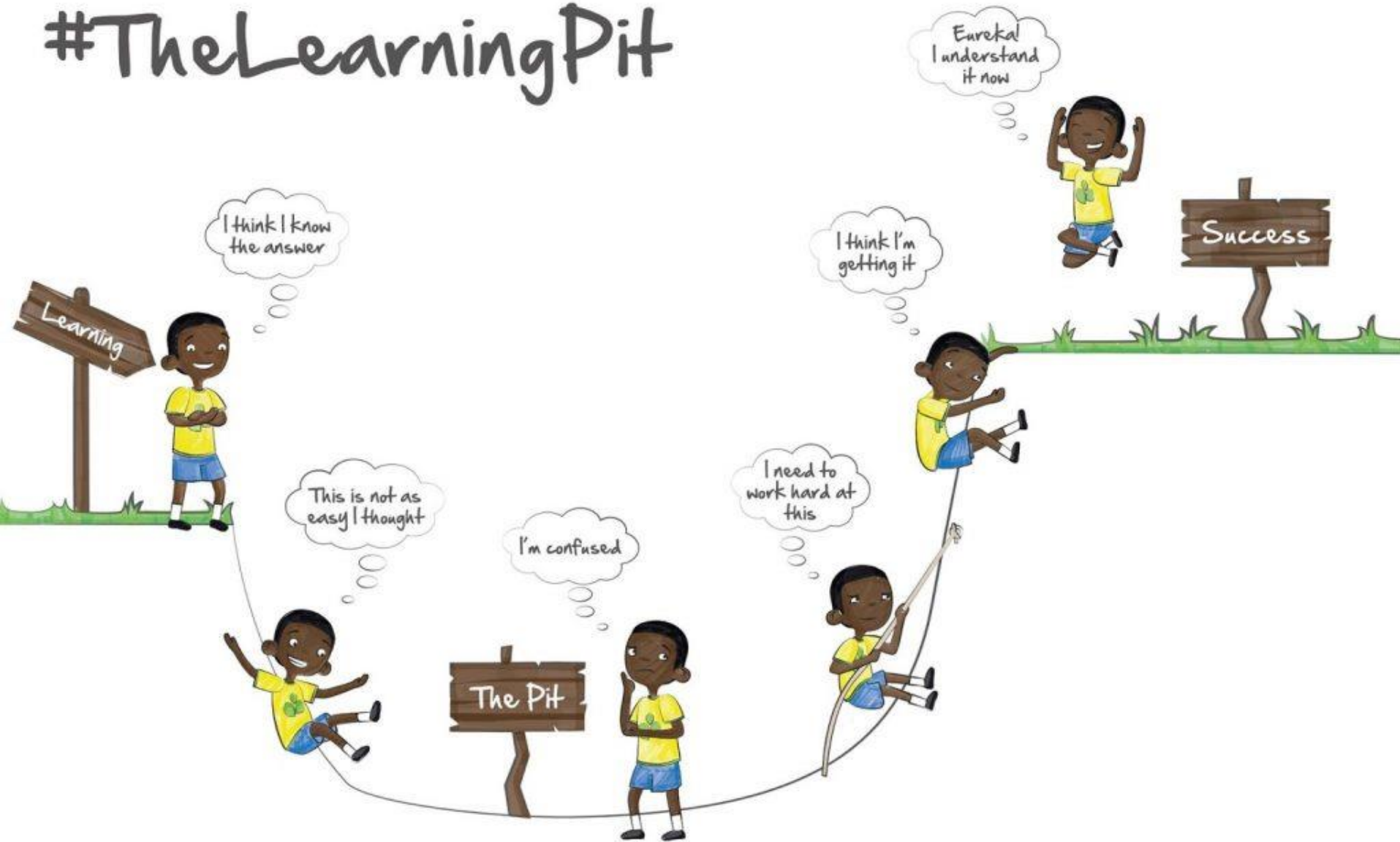


Our purpose in school is to learn.

The ideal conditions for new learning:

Tackling a concept or skill that will require dedicated mental and physical response that elicits thoughts such as 'This is hard' or 'I can't do this' and then using all the skills discussed previously, will result in deep learning (even although it feels demanding and challenging!)

# \* Why the Learning Pit?

Allows learners to make mistakes and learn from them

Can be easily differentiated so all learners are challenged appropriately

A pit lesson is dynamic and progress can be evaluated constantly

The pit allows learners to independently make connections between ideas

The pit encourages learners to be resilient, curious, reflective and supportive

Instead of ‘I can’t do it!’

‘I can’t do it... yet!’

Children need to learn to find things a challenge but also learn how to attack that challenge through trying different ways, using strategies and ‘having a go.’
