Parent Questions	<p>Robin Class: Recognised that some lovely photos have been added to the class page <i>Mrs Clark thanked parents for their comments.</i></p> <p>Personal thank you to all the staff involved in making the SeaCity trip such a success. The children have been really captivated by the topic and the personal stories of people on board the Titanic. <i>The hooks into topics are very important as they provide a platform for the children to take their learning on and are very engaging.</i></p> <p>Request - we appreciate that you will be leaving the school at the end of the term, but we wondered if you'd consider coming back for the Year 2 leavers assembly, if it is being held this year? We believe kids and parents would really appreciate this if it is possible. <i>Mrs Clark will speak to the new Headteacher but would be delighted to attend!</i></p> <p>Hedgehog Class With the world news, do teachers have a standard of which they use to answer any questions the children may openly ask, over current world events, including on the topic of war? <i>We do talk to the children about war during Remembrance. As of yet no child has asked questions about current affairs, if they do we will go along the idea of countries not agreeing.</i></p> <p>Some parents were sad to hear at parents evening their children are behind, particularly on the topic of the phonics screening. Is there a threshold that can be explained to parents of why it was only brought up at parents evening and not sooner? <i>We allow time for the children to settle down in Year 1 and the teaching of the phonics continues from Year R. The first testing of the phonics is in January, this allows gaps to be closed. We do ask all parents to read regularly with their children, this supports the child's acquisition of phonics.</i></p>

Outdoor learning	Mrs Clark took parents to watch the Active Dance and parents also wondered around the Outdoor Learning Provision. There were lots of very positive comments, parents had not realised how lovely Outdoor Learning was. A request was made for a video to be put onto the website for all parents to see.
